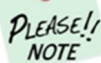

Due to the General Election taking place on the 8th June, the date for school photographs has changed to 21st June.

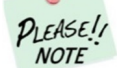


School will be closed on the **8th of June** as it will be used as a polling station for the **General election** which has been called for by the Prime Minister - Theresa May.
