Being sent out with the newsletter today are two documents in relation to how the school is meeting its responsibilities under the new General Data Protection Regulations (GDPR).



Privacy Notice – this explains what data we hold, how and why we use it and what your rights are in relation to it.

Additional Permissions – the vast majority of information we hold and use is due to legal requirements or subject to your specific permissions (i.e. use of photos). However there are a couple of areas where we felt it was important to clarify your permission. Therefore please complete the attached form and return it to your child's class teacher before half term

- Is wearing appropriate shoes (sandals should still have covered toes and heels please)

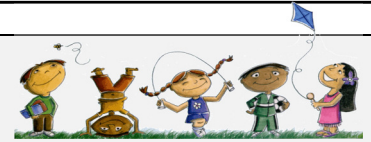

Subject: Shoppers Checklist Gaming Devices

If you are thinking about buying a gaming device for your child, why not print out the attached Shopper's Checklist and ask these important questions in the shop to help you inform your choice?



SHOPPER'S CHECKLIST

Buying a gaming device? Questions to ask in the shop

Gaming

- Is it possible to restrict access to games based on age ratings?
- How do I know if a game allows multiplayer gaming online?
- Is it possible to limit the amount of time my child can play their game?



Internet access

- Does this gaming device have internet access? What does this allow you to do?
- Is it possible to filter internet content that is potentially harmful for children?
- Is it possible to disable the internet browser to prevent my child from surfing the web?

Communication

- How can this gaming device be used to communicate with people by text, voice or video chat? Are there any parental controls to restrict this or ensure that my child only chats to people they know?

Films, Music and TV

- How can this device be used to watch films and TV or listen to music? Can I restrict access to content based on age ratings?

Costs

- How could my child run up a bill using their gaming device? Are there parental controls or ways of restricting spending?

Parental controls for different family members

- Can you put in place different parental control settings for each family member?
