Reading Tip 12:

What should I do if my child keeps choosing the same book?

There's always more to discover the second, third or even fourth time you read a book.

When you re-read a story with your child, take your time looking at the pictures and talk about the details you might not spot the first-time round. Asking them to tell you what happened in their own words is a great way to see what your child picked up on, and which parts resonated most.

E-Safety Tip of the week

Be Share Aware: talk about what's OK, and not OK, to share online. (part 1)

Talk to your child about what 'personal information' is - such as email address, full name, phone number, address and school name - and why it's important.

Explain simple ways to protect privacy. For example, avoiding usernames like birthdates or locations that give away too much information.
