Learning Tips

Reading Tip 15:

Get curious



There's always more to discover the second, third or even fourth time you read a book. When you re-read a story with your child, take your time looking at the pictures and talk about the details you might not spot the first-time round. Often you can find little characters and storylines hidden in the images.

Talk about your favourite pictures and what you can tell about the story from what you see. This will not only help deepen your child's understanding of the story, it also supports their visual literacy skills

E-Safety Tip of the week

Explore Sites and Apps Together

Talk about what might be OK for children of different ages. Ask your child what sites or apps they like. Write a list, and look at them together.

Be positive about what you see, but also be open about concerns you have: "I think this site's really good" or "I'm a little worried about things I've seen here".

Talk to your child about what you think is appropriate – but also involve them in the conversation. Ask what they think is OK for children of different ages – they'll feel involved in the decision-making.

Be aware that your child might talk about friends who use apps or visit sites that you've decided aren't suitable. Be ready to discuss your reasons, but recognise that they may not agree with you. Go through a final list of sites you both agree are OK, and work out when you'll next discuss it.
