Reading Tip 15:

Get comfortable!

Get comfortable! – Snuggle up together somewhere warm and cosy, whether it's in bed, on a beanbag or on the sofa. And make sure your child has somewhere comfy to read on their own too.



E-Safety Tip of the Week

Have the conversation

Have you asked about things your child (or their friends) may have online which made them feel uncomfortable?

- Be specific. What exactly made them feel uncomfortable and why?
- Is it people or animals being hurt?
- Nasty comments about others?

Tips for answers

1. Link these to things in the real world, and explain that you're always here to protect and help them online and off.
2. Reassure your child that they can always talk to you about anything that makes them feel uncomfortable.
3. Show them how to report or block on the sites and apps they use (Use Net Aware to find out how)
4. Tell them you'll help them to report anything upsetting they've seen, or to deal with online bullying.
5. Remember we are always here to help!
