GOLD GAMES MARK

Ellen Wilkinson achieve Gold for 3rd year in a row!



We are delighted to announce that we have achieved the School Games Gold Mark Award for the 2018/19 academic year.

The School Games Mark is a Government led award scheme launched in 2012, facilitated by the Youth Sport Trust to reward schools for their commitment to the development of competition across their school and into the community, and we are delighted to have been recognised for our success. Our sporting achievements this year include:

- 17 inter-school competitions attended.
- 14 active after-school clubs.
- 38 sports leaders were trained and ran events.

With many of our students competing in local inter-school competitions this year, we are extremely proud of our pupils for their dedication to all aspects of school sport, including those young volunteers, leaders and officials who made our competitions possible.

As part of our application, we were asked to fulfil criteria in the areas of participation, competition, workforce and clubs, and we are pleased that the hard work of everyone at our school has been rewarded this year. A special thanks to all the staff who have facilitated the competitions and clubs, accompanying the children to different venues across the borough, coaching and encouraging them.
