When is Parents Evening and where do I go?

This term's parents evening is being held from **3.30 pm – 7.00pm** on **Thursday 13th February 2020** and will be by appointment. Entry into the school is via the main front door and then through the main hall into your child's classroom. As always there are information stands from various community groups in the hall so please take time to stop and have a look. Books to support your child's learning will also be on sale. Lost property will also be out at this time. There is also a school lunch taster session in the hall.

How do I book an appointment?

Appointments are for 10 minutes. Please indicate on the slip **at least 2** time preferences. We try to allocate times as near to your preferences as possible, but I am sure you appreciate this is not always possible particularly at busy times (such as directly after school). Appointment time slots are allocated in the batch order we receive the forms back e.g. all the ones that came in Thursday morning, then Thursday pm etc. Please note this means that the fact that your form may have been the first of 10 that morning does not give it priority over the other 9! If you are not able to make the time slot given please speak to your child's class teacher as they may be able to arrange another date on which to meet. If you need to cancel on the day please let us know so we can allocate that time slot to someone else.

If you have more than 1 child in the school please fill out ONLY ONE FORM with the names of ALL your children. This needs to be returned to the oldest child's class teacher who will try to arrange appointments at a similar time. This can only happen if you return your form quickly.

***Your appointment time confirmation will be written in your child's home school book.**

What will this meeting include?

The focus of this term's meeting is:

- Particular strengths and areas for development
- Your child's progress towards end of year expectations
- What they need to do to achieve these, how we are helping in school and how you can support at home

There will be an opportunity for you to see your child's books both before and after your appointment time.

Is there anyone else I can talk to?

All members of the Senior Leadership team will be free to meet with you if you have any additional questions or queries. If you would like more information about inclusion (Special Educational Needs, Gifted & Talented or if your child has English as an additional language) please speak to Mrs Owen.
