Challenges:

English: Choose a book on Bug Club or a book from home and read it to your adult. Once you have read it, answer the following questions by writing the answers down. Maths - https://www.bbc.co.uk/bitesize/articles/zhvf382 . After each challenge, ask your child to explain how they found the answer.

Science: Last week, children learnt about animal diets. Recap this with your child and ask them to recall what a carnivore, herbivore and omnivore is and which animals are which. If children find it difficult to define the 3 animal diets then consider explaining it like this:

- 1. Carnivores are animals that only eat meat.
- 2. Herbivores are animals that only eat plants. The word 'herb' is a clue to help you remember this.
- 3. Omnivores are animals that eat both! The word 'om' at the beginning can be remembered through the phrase 'Om nom nom nom!' as those animals eat everything.

Home learning project: Before lockdown, children were given a home learning project based on a significant individual. Children can also continue working on this through the week. It could be focused on any significant individual from around the world, or your culture even! Projects can be in the form of a PowerPoint presentation, poster, 3D sculpture, artwork, etc.
