Dear Parents & Carers,

Feedback from Meet & Greet

It was lovely to see some of you on the Zoom Meet & Greet calls this week and feedback from those who attended was really positive.

However I am really concerned about the general low attendance (some classes only had 2 or 3 parents in total!) These 20 minute sessions were arranged as parents quite rightly wanted a chance to meet and speak to their child's teacher as due to COVID restrictions you can't meet them in person.

To have such low attendance is very concerning, particularly as the vast majority of you have used Zoom to access your child's class sessions during lockdown. In order to keep our community together and help our children begin to close the gaps in their learning it is essential that we work together which means we need <u>ALL</u> parents to engage.

Based on the recent government announcements the current COVID restrictions look likely to continue for many months and therefore we ask all parents and carers to please prioritise engaging with the school in future so that our children have the best chance to move forward.

Reporting Absence

We are asking all parents to please download the Studybugs app onto their phones and use this to report your child's absence. Details of this are provided below.

Sending Things Home

We will continue to avoid sending things home to you as much as possible but unfortunately this isn't always possible. Please be assured that we minimise contact with these items as much as possible and staff that distribute them sanitise their hands thoroughly and where possible wear gloves.

School lunches

We are hoping that cooked school lunches will resume early next week. Thank you for your patience in relation to this.

We're pleased to announce that Ellen Wilkinson is introducing a new, more efficient and secure system for reporting your child's absence due to illness, called Studybugs.

If you haven't already, please get the free Studybugs app, or register on the Studybugs website, and use it to tell us whenever your child's ill and unable to attend school.

<u>Advantages</u>

- You can report your child's illness straight away (and not wait for our opening hours)
- You will be linked to NHS information based on the symptoms you have entered (including possible COVID).
- The information you provide is put straight onto your child's attendance record.
