

Newham Libraries: How to Access a Computer:



Library Computers will be available for essential use during Lockdown

- Appointments can be booked in advance (telephone your library to book)
- You can drop by to use a PC during opening hours but you may need to wait if there are no PCs available
- There is a 15 minute space between bookings to allow for cleaning of equipment, desks and chairs between customers
- You will be asked to sanitise your hands when entering the library
- Use the NHS Track and Trace app to scan the QR Code for the library
- Library staff will offer support in using PCs where it is safe to do so and social distancing can be maintained.

Access to Learning Mentors

Our virtual 'Chill and Chat' sessions begin next week. These will take place via Zoom and be hosted by Ms Baker & Mr Hart.

They are a space just to have a chat with someone.

Parent Advice Phone-In with an Educational Psychologist (EP)

The EPS Parent Advice sessions are offered to any Newham parent or carer who would like to discuss concerns about their child with an educational psychologist (examples may include: your child's emotional well-being, challenging behaviours, learning progress, your relationship with your child or some of your own worries). The sessions aim to be supportive, confidential, and informal. Each session is 40 minutes.

Please note these are stand-alone, one-off sessions that do not result in follow-up work. They are free sessions and open to all parents and carers of Newham children and young people. There is no criteria or threshold to access these sessions.
