


Learning Gallery

COVID Question of the week

Q: SHOULD I NOTIFY THE SCHOOL IF MY CHILD HAS A POSITIVE TEST AFTER THE END OF TERM?



A: <u>Up to and including 6th April please inform the school if a pupil who attends the school tests positive. If it is a family member or your child comes into contact you do not need to let us know.</u>

After the 6th you do not need to complete the form but please email us to let us know and we will then contact you on the 19th. Do not send your child in on the 20th until you have spoken to us!

Q: HOW DO I INFORM THE SCHOOL?

A: There is a link on the front page of the website, or you can click on the link below. No other form of communication will be checked during this period. https://forms.gle/maP6sgePjwLYLu378

Q: WHAT HAPPENS NEXT?

A: The Senior Leadership Team is on duty from the end of school on the 1st until 6th April. This means that if we are notified of a positive case during this time we will follow similar procedures to if the school was open including contacting the DFE, LA & Public Health.

Therefore, if the positive case was in school during the infectious period we will be contacting families and staff to inform them they need to self-isolate for 10 days. Please note we will NOT be calling contacts individually but will send you a text message.

Q WHAT MUST WE DO IF YOU CONTACT US?

A: Your child will need to self-isolate for 10 days. This means they MUST NOT mix with other families even in gardens.
