Learning Fair

Toilets

Unfortunately, we are having difficulties with several toilets across the site because of a collapsed drain. We are working with the Local Authority to assess the extent of this and to get a permanent fix. In the short term 2 portable toilet blocks (with heating and hand washing facilities) will be brought in and located near the football pitch. One block will be

for staff and one block will be for children who usually use the failed toilets. Please note that most of the pupil toilets across the site are still working and we will continue to monitor this closely. We will of course apply our usual enhanced cleaning regime to the portable toilet blocks as well as the functioning toilets in the building. We will update you when we have further information.

Location and access to the site

- Please collect your child promptly as we have only 15 minutes between the two events on each night and staff are giving up their own time so these events can take place.
- We strongly suggest that as your child enters the hall that you take their coat away with you and bring it back when you collect them (this way they don't get muddled with someone else's)
