#### **Free School Meals**

Every primary school aged child attending school in Newham can have a free school lunch. However, if parents/carers qualify we would urge you to still complete the Free School Meals application as you could be accessing much more support including:

- Free after-school clubs
- Discounted residential visit (in years 5 & 6)
- Food vouchers during school holidays (dependent on government funding)
- Access to Holiday Activity programmes

This is only for school aged children and does not include those in nursery.

#### Eligibility for free school meal applications

Your child may receive free school meals if you get any of the following benefits:

- Income Support
- Income-based Jobseeker's Allowance
- Income-related Employment and Support Allowance
- Support under Part VI of the Immigration and Asylum Act 1999
- The guarantee element of Pension Credit
- Child Tax Credit (provided you're not also entitled to Working Tax Credit and have an annual gross income of no more than £16,190
- Working Tax Credit run-on paid for 4 weeks after you stop qualifying for Working Tax Credit
- Universal Credit if you apply on or after 1 April 2018 your household income must be less than £7,400 a year (after tax and not including any benefits you get)

#### **COVID advice of the week-** How has testing changed?

The guidance for types of testing changed yesterday (Tuesday 11th January 2022).



- If you or your child has symptoms you should still arrange a PCR
- However, if you or your child has a positive home test (no symptoms) you now do not need to get a PCR test to confirm. You should start your isolation period from the home test date.
- Please note if you wish to claim the Test and Trace Support Payment to financially support your isolation period you will need to do a PCR test.
