We are currently offering FREE training to young people aged 16-24 who are not in education, employment or training (NEET) in Construction and preparation for work. The aim is to help them gain their health and safety in construction qualification as well as CSCS card and be work ready.

The date for the next Construction/Preparation for work course will be on <u>Tuesday 9th November 2021</u>

Referral process

- Step 1: Pre Screening -This is to determine the young person's eligibility. Please send over their full name, contact number, DOB and full postcode.
- Step 2: IAG and sign up Once a young person is eligible we will book a face to face sign up appointment with them where they will also receive information, advice and guidance about their career choice and the construction programme.

Eligibility


- NEET aged 16-24
- Right to live and work in the UK a valid passport <u>OR</u> birth certificate
- Proof of address an official letter dated in the last 3 months such as a bank statement, utility bill or benefits letter
- NI number
- Looking for work, traineeship, apprenticeship or further education and able to start this after the programme

Photo ID: Our programme requires young people to sit an online health and safety test as well as attend a centre for their CSCS green card test. Both require photo ID so it's worth the young person having this in place before the course starts.

Progression

- During and following the programme, young people will be liaising with our progression team to understand the best next steps for them in their career. We work with local organisations within boroughs, who are ready and waiting to provide interviews and work experience, once they have achieved the above qualifications.
- We will work with the young person to bring together careers advice and guidance, employment, skills, apprenticeships and business support for them.
- Progression is an integral part of our programme. The training helps to prepare young people to enter the work place the progression team will help to find that right position.

ELOP Youth Out East LGBTQ+ Youth Group and Mentoring

We offer our service across London and the surrounding Essex boroughs

Youth Out East ~ Youth Group for LGBTQ+ young people aged 12-18. The sessions are a safe space to make friends, enjoy fun activities and discuss issues. They run every TUESDAY evening on zoom at the following time:

12-15s 5-6.30pm

15-18's 7-8.30pm

Youth Out East ~ Mentoring offers LGBTQ+ young people, aged 12-18, individual mentoring support sessions with a trained LGBTQ+ professional. The mentoring sessions are a safe, accepting, and affirming space where the young person is supported to identify their issues and concerns, and to set goals for the sessions. This could include a space and opportunity to:

- explore their LGBTQ+ identities
- develop strategies to build and
- sustain confidence, self-acceptance, and pride develop coping mechanisms for future coming out, or dealing with anti-LGBTQ+ hate gain increased knowledge and information on sexual orientation and gender identities and/ or LGBTQ+ rights.

Our LGBTQ+ youth mentoring is <u>not</u> therapy or a clinical intervention and should not be used as an alternative should either be needed. Our mentoring service is free and can be held via phone or online until we fully return to a physical face-to-face service. Sessions are usually weekly, for 6 weeks and last for up to one hour/ session.







Reporting Indecent Images

Children and the Internet Watch Foundation (IWF) have launched a new tool which allows children and young people, or trusted adults on their behalf, to report a nude image or video of themselves so that the IWF can take steps to remove it from the internet.

You can report an image/video that hasn't been uploaded or shared. The IWF will assign a 'hash' to prevent the image being uploaded by anyone.

Image hashing is the creation of a unique digital description/copy of an image that can be used by the image being uploaded or shared, and prevent that action from asking place.
