Polio

Following recent [news reports](#) we wanted to reassure residents that polio is a very, very rare disease nowadays due to successful vaccination programmes around the world and there have been no cases in the UK for many years.

Polio is one of the diseases that children are routinely vaccinated against, so most people in Newham will have had the vaccine. If you have had the full course of vaccines, you will have life-long protection against Polio.
