




December Events Information

Christmas Discos

Dates and times

Monday 4th December: 3.45 - 4.45 (Reception) & 5.00 - 6.00 (Years 1 & 2) Monday 11th December: 3.45 - 5.00 (Years 3 & 4) & 5.15 - 6.30 (Years 5 & 6)

Location and access to the site

- All discos will be held in the hall and will be supervised by school staff.
- Parents need to use the Mitchell Walk gate (at the back of the school) to access the site.
- Children need to line up with their adult by the hall doors and give their ticket to gain entry.
- Collection is from the same place.

<u>Tickets</u>

Available on Parentmail @ £2 per child. Paper tickets will be given to children on the day so they don't get lost.

Further information

- Please note all children must be collected from school at 3.15pm as usual. Children who are not collected will not be allowed to attend the event and ticket money will be refunded.
- <u>ALL</u> children including Year 6 must be collected.
- Please collect your child promptly as we have only 15 minutes between the two events on each night and staff are giving up their own time so these events can take place.
- We strongly suggest that as your child enters the hall that you take their coat away with you and bring it back when you collect them (this way they don't get muddled with someone else's)
- Sorry no parents can attend the discos.
- Discos are NO PHOTOGRAPHY events (this includes mobile phones).
- This is a non-uniform event.
- Children are responsible for any money they have.
- There will be flashing lights and loud music so please bear this in mind when booking if your child is sensitive to this.

Who, When and Where?

- Open to EWPS families

- Children must be collected by an adult as normal at the end of the school day year 5 & 6 parents we will contact you separately.
- Any child not collected will not be able to access the event.
- Once released from the class door children are then under the supervision of the collecting adult as all school staff will be involved.

- Food and drinks prices will vary
- Please note <u>cash only</u> for stalls please as we have no capacity for card payments for so many activities.
