#### **AFTER SCHOOL CLUBS - SUMMER TERM 2024**

Here are details of the Summer Term After School Clubs that we will be running. Many clubs have stayed the same as last term - please check the information attached.

#### The following information is very important so please read it if carefully

#### When will After School Clubs start?

All After School Clubs will start from Monday 22nd April 2024 and run until approximately Friday 05th July 2024. However, due to some School Events (such as Parent Evenings and Summer Fair etc - some clubs may continue into the next week (ending Friday 12 July 2024). Full dates of when clubs run are listed below against each club.

#### **How much to After School Clubs cost?**

The cost of each club is £5.00 per session, per child. This means for each club that your child attends it will cost £50 for a 10 week block. PLEASE NOTE THAT CLUBS ON THURSDAYS FOR THIS TERM ONLY WILL RUN FOR A MAXIMUM OF 9 WEEKS (DUE TO OTHER EVENTS / SCHOOL COMMITMENTS).

#### Do I have to pay if my child is eligible for Free School Meals?

Yes. We currently provide a 50% discount to those who qualify for Free School Meals status. This will reduce the cost to £2.50 per club (£25 for each 10 week club).

#### How do I know if I am eligible for Free School Meal status?

- When you go on Parentmail you will only see the clubs that your child can attend for their age and also the rate at which they will need to pay. Once all Free School Meal places have been sold, you may still purchase a place for that club but it will have to be at the full price rate (£5.00 per session).
- If you think you are eligible for the lower 50% rate but the option does not show then please contact Miss Baker.

#### How does it work?

- ALL PURCHASES WILL BE ON A FIRST COME / FIRST SERVED BASIS AND PAYMENT MUST BE MADE AT THE TIME OF BOOKING. NO PAYMENT = NO CLUB.
- You must pay for the full term's worth of clubs upfront (at the time of booking).
- There will be no refunds for illness, non-attendance or for attending only a few sessions.

#### How do I book?

- It will run on a similar basis as to how we run Parents Evening. Everything will be run through Parentmail.
- All Clubs will go live to purchase on FRIDAY 22nd MARCH 2024 at 8.00AM.
- You will be able to reserve a club place for your child(ren) for a maximum of 20 minutes only.
- Once you have selected the club(s) for your child choose "Add to Basket" for each club and it will reserve the place and put it into your Parentmail basket the space will only be held for a maximum of 20 minutes..
- If you do not pay for the club booking(s) within 20 minutes the place(s) will be released back into the booking system and other parents will have the chance to purchase them.
- If club places sell out initially try again in about another 20-30 minutes, as some parents may not have completed their purchase in time and those spaces will have been released back into the booking system.

#### What club places are on offer?

Our After School clubs are for Years 1 to 6. Please discuss with your child their options and the clubs they may want to attend. A list of the clubs that are available and the number of spaces for each club are at the end of this letter.

#### Can my child attend more than one club per day?

No - Your child can only attend a club within their age range and you can only purchase one club per day for each child. Your child can attend up to 5 clubs but only one per day (subject to availability). **Remember - only book one club per day per child.**

#### What are the dates and times of clubs?

- All clubs run for 1 hour from 3.30pm until 4.30pm.
- All club dates can be found at the end of this letter.
- You will notice that due to certain events during the term (events such as Parents Evening and the Winter Fayre) this will mean that not all clubs will finish during the same week.
- Please ensure you note which dates your clubs are planned to run on.
- It is your responsibility to ensure that you are aware when each club will run / not run.

#### What if all places for the club I want have been sold?

- If all places have been sold for the club(s) that you want, you can add your child's name to the club waitlist.
- You can add yourself to a waitlist on the Parentmail Screen when you try and buy a place for a sold out club. The system will offer you the chance to add your child's name to the waitlist at that time.
- We will try to increase the capacity of some clubs (where we can) should demand exceed supply. However, for certain clubs this may not be possible.
- Also, if there are any unsold Free School Meal places left unsold after 72 hours of the clubs going live, then
  these will be made available to those who are club waitlist(s). HOWEVER it is highly likely that your child will
  only get a place (if on the waitlist) if another child drops out or a purchase is not made in time.

#### What happens to those on the waitlist(s)

If you put your name onto the waitlist for a club, we will contact you on **Wednesday 17th April 2024**, if we are able to create further places.

If we do not contact you on this date then we are sorry but ALL waitlist applications have been <u>unsuccessful</u> - all club places have been sold.

#### What happens if all club places have been sold and my waitlist application is unsuccessful?

Check to see if there is another club being run at the same time / same day that your child could attend (there may be still some spaces). If there are no other clubs that suit your needs then you will need to make alternate arrangements for your child (especially if you are using clubs for childcare).

#### What happens if not enough children apply for the club?

If a club does not have a minimum number of children attending then it will not run. We will refund any monies paid if this happens (or offer an alternative club - if one is available).

#### How will I know if my child has got a club - their place(s)?

Once you have made your payment you will receive a receipt - this is your confirmation that your child has a place for the club that you have purchased. We will also email you during next week to confirm the club dates / session times. If you want to know these dates now then they are listed under each club at the bottom of this letter.

#### How do I collect my child?

Details of how and where to collect your child will be sent to you. Please make sure you collect your child on time (4.30pm). Failure to do so may result in them being stopped from attending after school clubs.

#### My child missed a session or no longer wants to attend, can I get my money back?

All outstanding sessions were delivered in the last term. Once you have agreed and paid for a club **there is no refund if your child no longer wishes to attend**. We have committed as a school to paying for these clubs and providing a place for your child - so no money can be returned in any circumstance.

#### Cancellation of Clubs

We will limit this happening where it is possible to do so (if we have appropriate staff who can cover the session etc). If the club does need to be cancelled because the person who runs it is unavailable (and there is no cover) then we will let you know as soon as possible. Unfortunately sometimes this could be on the day of the club. We will arrange for a replacement date/session if this regrettably occurs.

#### No clubs will run during the final 2 weeks of term

Currently we are not planning to run any clubs after **Friday 05th July 2024** (unless detailed in the attached sheet) due to the end of term (and other planned activities in the final 2 weeks).



We will review this (after the May half-term) whether we can run some ad-hoc After School Clubs in the last two weeks but due to events that take place at that time of year (Awards Nights and Year 6 Leaver Events) we are unlikely to have scope to deliver these as they are subject to there being staff, time and building space, as well as demand!

PLEASE START TO THINK ABOUT MAKING ALTERNATE ARRANGEMENTS FOR THE LAST TWO WEEKS OF TERM (W/C 08 July and 15 July) - IN CASE WE CANNOT OFFER YOU ANYTHING -
