Measles spreads very easily among those who are unvaccinated, especially in nurseries and schools. It can be a very unpleasant illness and, in some children, can be very serious. Vaccines are our best line of defence against diseases like measles and can help stop outbreaks within our community.

If you're a parent or carer, please ensure your children are up to date with their two free MMR doses. You can do this by checking their red book or contacting your GP practice. If you're an adult who missed out on the jabs as a child, you can catch up for free at any time by simply contacting your GP.
