Examples may include: a football shirt, traditional clothing, or clothing in the colour scheme of your flag.


#### **Reminders:**

# Free app to manage bills and benefits

Newham have teamed up with SuperFi to provide residents with access to their easy-to-use mobile app which can help people to better manage their bills and debts, especially those wanting to manage their finances in a high cost of living environment. From receiving reminders on your monthly bills (such as Council Tax or utilities), accessing discounts from your favourite retailers, easily viewing and/or cancelling your subscriptions to even checking if you're receiving all of the government benefits you're entitled to.

### Free childcare for working parents

As part of the Government's expansion of the 30-hour entitlement, working parents may now be eligible to access 15 hours of free childcare for their two-year-olds from April. You may be eligible for Up to 15 hours of early education over 38 weeks of the year for 2 year olds or up to 30 hours of early education over 38 weeks of the year for 34 year olds.

The offer can be used flexibly with one or more childcare providers whilst some providers will allow you to 'stretch' the hours over 52 weeks, using fewer hours per week.
