




### Council rolls out weekly food waste recycling service

The council is introducing weekly food waste recycling collections from later this month.

Around one in ten households across the borough will be given new food waste caddies, outdoor bins, and introductory liners. All of this will help residents separate food waste from their general rubbish. It will reduce waste, cut carbon emissions, and create renewable energy and fertiliser from recycled food. The service will be rolled out across all areas of the borough in three phases by 2027.
