Most of our preschool parents will have received news of which school their child has been allocated for Reception and Primary School. **If your child turns 4 before the 31st August 2024 and you have not made an application**, can I suggest you send an urgent email to [schooladmission@newham.gov.uk](mailto:schooladmission@newham.gov.uk) in order to work out what your next steps will be.

Class 3 (Pre Schoolers) will begin work this term on transition and securing strong foundations. Attached to the email you will have the new DfE approved **Starting Reception** booklet supporting you in the transition process. All preschoolers leaving us this year will be given their annual reports and emailed their child's Evidence Me profile to share with the new school. We also ask that you inform us of which school your child will be attending so that we can ensure a transition report is sent to the new school to prepare them with information about your child.

This month has been busy with activity. We ensure we are keeping up with our library visits and thank you for your co-operation in bringing in the books and folders when requested. Pre-schoolers do have homework books that began in October and this has helped to reinforce the learning that takes place in class. Please continue to help your child at home.

April has been busy with new starters joining us. We welcome you into our little family. We hope you will over time see your children thrive and be the best versions of themselves in the coming months. We attach the Potty Training Booklet developed to support parents in this challenging journey. Please note that we will support you as you begin this journey, and the staff will use the warmer weather to encourage you to begin this process if they can see your child is ready.

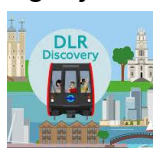
